The last and final event was the Start-Up Simulator. Each team had an investor, employee and entrepreneur. Investors and entrepreneurs were required to get maximum investments. This had to be more than 15 lakhs. The employee had to acquire the best package deal of a company i.e stakes in the company, general salary and benefits etc.

While Sardar Patel Vidyalaya claimed most of the prizes, Modern School Barakhamba took away the overall trophy.
