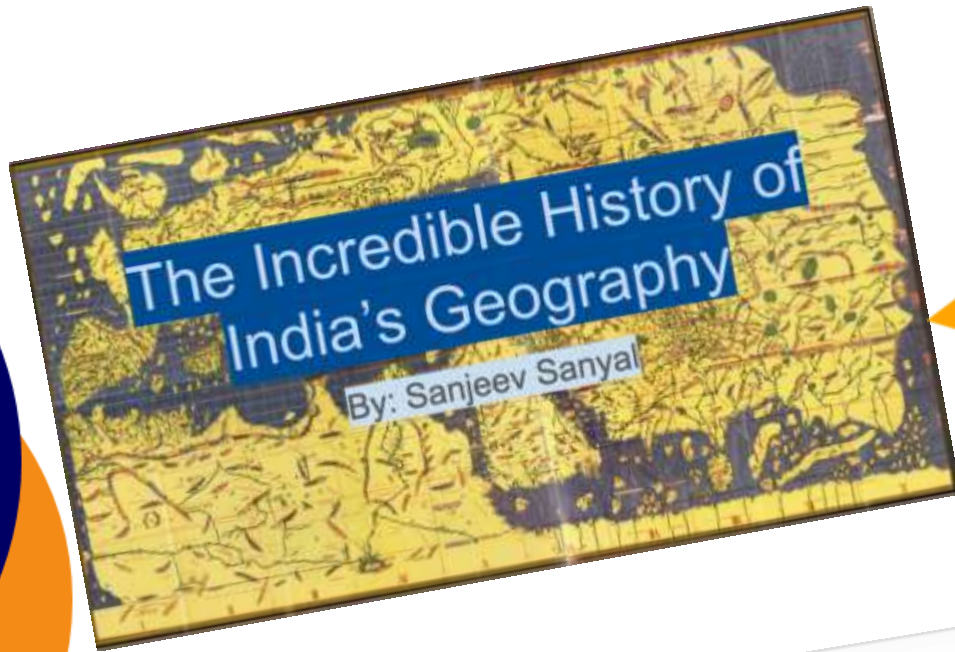

Guardians Summaries

 - *You can unsubscribe or remove yourself from Classroom at any time.*
- Ensure that the **details submitted** by you (Parent) on school website are **complete and updated**.
