27<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> April, 2017, witnessed immense debate, discussion and negotiation, coated with a veil of diplomacy. Students from more than 20 school of India and abroad took on the role of representatives of nations and even portfolios of ministers, presenting their interests and understanding others' to reach a middle ground- a place of peace.

The delegates changed the history of the Middle East in the Historical Security Council, and made history in the Commission of Human Rights. They found ways to combat the illegal drug trade in the Commission on Narcotic Drugs, decided the fate of the Germans in 1933 in the Deutsches Reich, and delved into NATO's relationship with Russia in the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation. Throughout, the reporters, cartoonists and photographers of the International Press covered the happenings of the committees in their daily newsletter, *The Presspective*.

The students of Sanskriti spent weeks preparing for this Inter-school event, organizing not only the logistics, but also handling the committees independently. SMUN has time and again proved to be a platform for our students to harness their potential as global leaders, who will be change makers of tomorrow. By stimulating various committees, they got a chance to experience the practical implications of the decisions of the power-holders, and by representing countries unheard of, they learnt to empathize with people miles away and impact the lives of common people.
